Sisseton Wahpeton Students,

Due to the disruption in your academic studies at Sisseton Wahpeton College (SWC), there have been additional funding mechanisms put in place by several funding organizations and extremely great friends of SWC. We are very grateful for this opportunity! You will be able to supplement your disarray with funds to assist you complete this 2020 Spring Semester.

Some of the funds require that you be a student who is PELL eligible, but other funding resources do not have this requirement. However, Sisseton Wahpeton College has determined that if you have not logged into eLearning to attend to your classes and are not making adequate academic progress, you will not be eligible for these extra funds. The first allotment of funds will be distributed on April 24, 2020 to those students who are making progress towards a successful completion of their coursework. The first student disbursement will be for full-time students for about \$250 and part-time students will get about \$125. You will be notified via "One Call" or "email" that your check will be in the mail. Faculty will be notifying us about your attendance and academic progress in your courses up until April 23, 2020. Therefore, you have time to get logged into eLearning, be responsible students, and get your work completed.

An additional disbursement will be sent out to those who have successfully completed the semester with a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) or better. We expect this to take place on or about May 7, 2020.
