The Women's Basketball Coach is responsible for all aspects of the women's basketball program as well as being committed to the academic mission of the College. The Coach teaches the sport of basketball to student athletes, and provides for the coaching, recruitment and retention of women's basketball players.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- 1. Coach the women's basketball team, coaching and teaching the sport of basketball to student athletes.
- 2. Work with basketball players providing daily planning, organization and supervision of practices and competitions, and complete all associated logistics.
- 3. Recruit prospective student athletes.
- 4. Supports student-athlete academic success by ensuring students are meeting the College's academic progress expectations.
- 5. Models and encourages leadership, sportsmanship, and teamwork.
- 6. Monitor and maintain the discipline and conduct of student athletes to support the image and reputation of SWC's athletics program.
- 7. Ensure all rules and regulations of the NJCAA and other applicable organizations are followed, which includes submitting the necessary paperwork to begin SWC's basketball program's participation in any and all appropriate organizations.
- 8. Duties and responsibilities are to be carried out in a manner which promotes and is consistent with the Dakota Values.
- 9. Participates in professional development and grant related workshops, SWC committees, and faculty/staff meetings.
- 10. Complies with all SWC, Tribal, and Federal policies, regulations and laws that govern the College.
- 11. Performs other duties as assigned.
